ORAL HISTORIES OF IRISH SENIORS IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA

The Claddagh Association with the support of the Irish Government and AIHA have published a book of life stories of Irish elders in our local community compiled by professional media interviewers, titled 'FROM HOME TO HOME'.

The books will not be sold. They will be gifted to accomplish the aims of the project - create connections between generations in the Irish community of WA, highlight the history of the Irish community in WA, and contribute to the ongoing identity formation of the Irish community in WA.

The book will be launched at a strictly invitation-only event in Fremantle on Thursday 10 December from 5 to 7 pm. Numbers are restricted due to Covid regulations and therefore the invitation is limited to community groups. The Honorary Irish Consul Marty Kavanagh will launch the publication. There will be a presentation to the CEO of the State Library of WA of audio files and transcripts, as well as a celebration (including Irish dancing and music) with the participants of the Oral History Project. Invitations have been extended to Irish Australian politicians, Steven Dawson, Minister for Environment, Disability Services and Electoral Affairs, Jessica Stojkovski MLA, Kate Doust, President of the Legislative Council and Alanna Clohesy MLC.

Breandán Ó Caollaí, Ambassador of Ireland to Australia, wrote the foreword and the chapters are made up of edited excerpts from each interview. This publication was prepared for wide dissemination and will be available for download at Claddagh's website after the launch (www.claddagh.org.au). The *Irish Scene* will serialise the chapters of 'From Home to Home' over their next ten issues.
